On Friday, January 14, 2022 at 6:01 pm, RESIDENT ADVISOR [redacted] called RESIDENT DIRECTOR [redacted] who was on Upper Campus Area Duty, requesting guidance on a call that they had received from DESK ATTENDANT [redacted] who was working in the PHC. RA [redacted] stated that the call was regarding RESIDENT HAOYU WANG. RA [redacted] stated that DA [redacted] received a call from RESIDENT ZHIFAN DONG, RESIDENT DONG reported that RESIDENT WANG was making suicidal threats and acted on endangering behaviors towards RESIDENT DONG. RD [redacted] told RA [redacted] that she would take over the situation. RD [redacted] called Area Coordinator Duty, who was [redacted]. After the call, RD [redacted] called MH1 [redacted] to request support in making contact with RESIDENT WANG. AT 6:43 PM RD [redacted] and MH1 [redacted] reported to Sage Point [redacted] and were unsuccessful in making contact with RESIDENT WANG at their residency. RD [redacted] and MH1 [redacted] headed to RD [redacted]'s office to locate RESIDENT WANG's phone number, the number was not in service. RD [redacted] called DA [redacted] to get an understanding of the call that they received and to get the name and phone number of the reporting party. DA [redacted] stated that RESIDENT DONG had called to request a wellness check on her ex-partner due to their mental state and actions that occurred previously. RD [redacted] called AC DUTY [redacted] to receive guidance on how to move forward. AC DUTY [redacted] instructed RD [redacted] to make contact with RESIDENT DONG and get a better understanding of their report. RD [redacted] and MH1 [redacted] went to Sage Point [redacted], they asked RESIDENT DONG if they could speak in RD [redacted]'s office in which they agreed too. RESIDENT DONG disclosed the following:

"I am Haoyu's ex-girlfriend. Three nights ago (Wednesday, January 12, 2022), Haoyu and I had a little argument. We both have depression and are in a bad situation. He wanted me to leave the room so I began to pack my bags. He turned off the lights, he stated I was disturbing his sleep. He then held my neck and arms down, he thought I was going to harm myself. I began to scratch him to get him off. He began to hit me. I got scared, I quickly packed my stuff, the hotel front desk (not UGH) helped me call the police. That I know of, he was in jail for an hour. I called the police to make sure he was safe. The police cannot tell me where he is, he might be in hospital - thats all they can tell me. During this time he was talking to his mom, his mom has last heard from him 30 hours ago. I just want to make sure he is safe."

RD [redacted] thanked RESIDENT DONG for sharing what had occurred and asked if they needed any support tonight, RESIDENT DONG stated that they were okay. MH1 [redacted] asked RESIDENT DONG if they had a working number for RESIDENT WANG which the following number was provided: [redacted] RD [redacted] shared that she would enter a CARE report for both of RESIDENT WANG & DONG and that the resident outreach coordinator team would reach out to next week as early as Tuesday. RD [redacted] informed RESIDENT DONG that she was unable to do much to help locate RESIDENT WANG based on the information provided. RD [redacted] shared the Upper Area Duty number and UUPD number with RESIDENT DONG in case they heard from RESIDENT WANG and/or if RESIDENT WANG came back and they felt unsafe. After the call, RD [redacted] called AC [redacted]

DUTY to update her on the information. AC DUTY: stated that she would pull the UID card tap for
 RESIDENT WANG, RESIDENT WANG last tapped into Sage point 811 on Tuesday, January 11, 2022. AC DUTY
 requested a report be submitted and that no further action was needed. MH1 departed from RD s office at
 7:42 pm.

I had an outreach visit last night (1/14/2022) with Zhifan Dong. There should be a report in Advocate from Zhifan was open to follow-up with a resident outreach coordinator.

Here are the details...

HRE was contacted by the client's friend who had concerns about client's well-being after client had an argument with client's former romantic male partner. Both are international students. HRE contacted MH1 to provide support. Met with client and HRE staff in the Sage Point office. Interpreter services were not available. Client stated she could complete the interview/ assessment in English.

Client reported that she had an argument with her former partner 3 days ago in an off-campus hotel after client attempted to end the relationship. Client reported that as the argument escalated, she tried to leave the hotel room, was physically assaulted by her partner, and had a physical altercation with him. Client stated she got to the hotel front desk, called the police, and the partner was detained for one hour. Client reported that both she and her former partner have a history of depression and hospitalizations. Client reported the former partner made comments about suicide after the altercation. Client reported that she has not had any contact with the partner since the altercation. Client said that he has not been responding to her text. Client reported that the partner has been in contact with his mother, but the mother hasn't heard from him in 30 hours. Client noted that she tried contacting the police and hospitals but was not given any information due to confidentiality. Client expressed her worries for her former partner's well-being.

HRE noted that there had not been building access from Wang and Dong on the following dates 1/14, 1/21, 2/1, and 2/7.

UUPD has Wang listed as a missing person within the database because while she communicated via FaceTime and showed her hotel room, her location cannot be confirmed and she was not physically seen. Her location was pinged via cellphone as downtown but 7+ hotels have been checked under her name and she was not located. CSS and OEO outreach has been sent regarding resources and services and only a text message of "thanks" was received. Discussed utilization of campus resources to translate from English to her native language. Unsure if Wang has not been in HRE because she does not feel safe in the space if Dong is also present in HRE or if the two are together in the hotel off campus.

HRE staff had spoken with Dong and he is not considered a missing person though his location is not known at the time and he has not accessed HRE. Based on when he was released from jail the protective order indicates that he would need to stay away from Wang. Dong has completed the Utah Global program and housing can be identified through them off campus if he returns. Dong currently does not meet course eligibility and is out of status with ISSS requirements.

Action Items –

HRE – Outreach to Dong to communicate that he is not allowed within HRE and request his current housing location.

ODOS/HRE/ISSS– Communication with Utah Global to share information and make contact with families.

UUPD - Any updates regarding Wang and her location or communication should be reported directly to

Mother of Zhifan conversation on 2/9/2022 at 9:45pm MT

In attendance:

Preface to the meeting: Zhifan was in contact with her mother about 9pm MT which was conveyed from Utah Global coordinator. Zhifan spoke with [redacted] this evening and shared that she is safe, she is alone, she is not in Salt Lake City, and [redacted] stressed the importance of meeting in person. Goal is to have mom help to facilitate an in-person meeting with Zhifan and to share where our concern is coming from.

Utah Global translators and Zhifan's mother joined the call

[redacted] : Introduced himself and then shared our concern for Zhifan because we have not seen her in 10 days and she won't share where she is. He shared they spoke on the phone and she said she was coming back Friday but [redacted] is concerned that she will not meet with him in person. We are concerned for her safety because we are worried that her ex-boyfriend is threatening her or making her scared for her safety. Has she shared with her mother anything that has been going on with her?

Zhifan's mother: Right after [redacted] spoke with her she spoke with her mother. Mother had face to face video chat with her and said her daughter is emotionally sad and encouraged her daughter to meet with [redacted] on Friday.

[redacted] : Said he would meet with her anywhere she wanted and would bring friends (UUPD and counselor) for support.

Zhifan's mother: Her daughter claimed she just wanted to be alone for a bit because of the break up.

[redacted] : If she wishes to not be in the halls we can definitely make that happen but the police are worried she is being held against her will or hiding so that is why we want to meet her in person so we can make sure she is safe and see she is not hurt.

Zhifan's mother: She is returning Friday.

[redacted] : She would not verify and give time and location. That is what he is seeking from her. [redacted] will text and email her tonight. If [redacted] does not receive a response from Zhifan then we will need to let Utah Global know so they can reach out to the mother.

Zhifan's mother: Had no further questions. She is going to contact her daughter and continue to push her.

Friday January 14, 2022: writes care report CO0197-022

Tuesday January 18, 2022: I was assigned the care case and sent Zhifan and Haoyu (Chester) meeting request emails. (Monday we were closed for MLK day which is why they went out of Tuesday instead of Monday).

Wednesday January 19, 2022: I attempted to call both students as I had not heard back from my emails. Left Zhifan a voicemail asking to please contact me. Chester's number was a non-working line so I could not leave a voicemail.

Monday January 24, 2022: Performed wellness check for both students. Zhifan was not home, but was able to make contact with Chester. We spoke about his mental health and he informed me he was scheduled at the counseling center later that day. Stated he did not need any further assistance at that time. I let him know I'd check back in later. Tried calling Zhifan again and still no answer.

Monday January 31, 2022: Attempted another wellness check on Zhifan, she was not home but her roommate was. Roommate wasn't sure where she was but asked to meet with me about a separate issue.

Tuesday February 8, 2022: Met with the roommate about the issue, afterwards I asked if she had seen Zhifan since we last spoke. Roommate then disclosed it had been over a week since she saw her. Had pull swipe records and we discovered Zhifan hadn't swiped into the building since January 28th. I attempted to call/text Zhifan again and discovered the number we had on file was incorrect. (the person I had been contacted finally informed me it was a wrong number). Found Zhifan's correct number and called/texted her to see if I could make contact. I then called UPD to file missing person report. A few hours later Zhifan responded to my text as well as UPD's texts stating she was "resting" off campus and that she was safe. UPD attempted to face time her, and while she answered that call she refused to show herself on camera.

HRE noted that there had not been building access from Wang and Dong on the following dates 1/14, 1/21, 2/1, and 2/7.

UUPD has ^{Dong}Wang listed as a missing person within the database because while she communicated via FaceTime and showed her hotel room, her location cannot be confirmed and she was not physically seen. Her location was pinged via cellphone as downtown but 7+ hotels have been checked under her name and she was not located. CSS and OEO outreach has been sent regarding resources and services and only a text message of "thanks" was received. Discussed utilization of campus resources to translate from English to her native language. Unsure if ^{Dong}Wang has not been in HRE because she does not feel safe in the space if ^{Dong}Dong is also present in HRE or if the two are together in the hotel off campus.

HRE staff had spoken with ^{Wang}Dong and he is not considered a missing person though his location is not known at the time and he has not accessed HRE. Based on when he was released from jail the protective order indicates that he would need to stay away from ^{Dong}Wang. ^{Wang}Dong has completed the Utah Global program and housing can be identified through them off campus if he returns. ^{Dong}Dong currently does not meet course eligibility and is out of status with ISSS requirements.

Action Items –

HRE – Outreach to ^{Wang}Dong to communicate that he is not allowed within HRE and request his current housing location.

ODOS/HRE/ISSS– Communication with Utah Global to share information and make contact with families.

UUPD - Any updates regarding ^{Dong}Wang and her location or communication should be reported directly to Heather.

In attendance:

Preface to the meeting: Zhifan was in contact with her mother about 9pm MT which was conveyed from Utah Global coordinator. Zhifan spoke with [redacted] this evening and shared that she is safe, she is alone, she is not in Salt Lake City, and [redacted] stressed the importance of meeting in person. Goal is to have mom help to facilitate an in-person meeting with Zhifan and to share where our concern is coming from.

Utah Global translators and Zhifan's mother joined the call

[redacted] : Introduced himself and then shared our concern for Zhifan because we have not seen her in 10 days and she won't share where she is. He shared they spoke on the phone and she said she was coming back Friday but [redacted] s concerned that she will not meet with him in person. We are concerned for her safety because we are worried that her ex-boyfriend is threatening her or making her scared for her safety. Has she shared with her mother anything that has been going on with her?

Zhifan's mother: Right after [redacted] spoke with her she spoke with her mother. Mother had face to face video chat with her and said her daughter is emotionally sad and encouraged her daughter to meet with [redacted] on Friday.

[redacted] : Said he would meet with her anywhere she wanted and would bring friends (UUPD and counselor) for support.

Zhifan's mother: Her daughter claimed she just wanted to be alone for a bit because of the break up.

[redacted] : If she wishes to not be in the halls we can definitely make that happen but the police are worried she is being held against her will or hiding so that is why we want to meet her in person so we can make sure she is safe and see she is not hurt.

Zhifan's mother: She is returning Friday.

The following is a summary of the conversation:

- Mr. Wang started the conversation with, "Who is going to pay?" I misunderstood and thought he was talking about the temp housing and I told him I would pay for him to live in an alt location, how quickly does he need it, etc...
- Mr. Wang corrected me and stated, "No, who is going to pay for my lost reputation when I am found innocent of being a domestic abuser?" I told him I did not understand who/how to pay.
